

DM Baramulla chairs DLSCC meeting

Rs. 31.lacs sanctioned among Militancy victims

Baramulla 26 March: -A meeting of District level screening Cum Co-ordination Committee (DLSCC) was today held under the chairmanship of District Magistrate Baramulla, Dr. Nassir Ahmad Naqash.

A total of 25 cases were taken up, out of which 11 cases were cleared and various cases were deferred for want for clarification and permission for re-examination. Out of the 11 cases, 08 pertained to cash compensation and Rs. 4 lakh were sanctioned for each of the 08 cases and 2 cases were cleared for appointment. While as Rs.7 lacs were sanctioned in favour of 01 Case for property damaged. The eligibility including qualification of the applicants was also taken into account while deciding the appointments cases. The Reports from Police, CID and Army were thoroughly discussed while deciding the cases. All the necessary guidelines as per SRO-43 were also kept in view. Meanwhile, Re-verification and dependent certificates in some cases was sought during the meeting.
