

Advisor reviews security situation in Baramulla

Baramulla, 18 July: Advisor to Governor Vijay Kumar today chaired a meeting with top Security brass here at dak bungalow Sopore to review the overall security situation prevailing in the district.

Meeting was attended by Chief Secrertray BVR Subramanyam,ADGP,Muneer Ahmad Khan,Divisional Commissioner Baseer Ahmad Khan,IGP Kashmir,DC Baramulla and various other officers.

On the occasion, the Advisor calls for close synergy between security agencies in maintaining peace in the district. He stresses for adopting SOPs in letter and spirit for effective management of law and order situation. Moreover, he exhorted upon the concerned for creating friendly and conducive environment and to bridge the gap between people and police at large.

Earlier, the advisor was briefed by the DDC about the security situation in the district wherein he informed that the security situation had remained comparatively normal. He said that several initiatives have been taken by the District administration for streamlining the traffic management system.

Meanwhile the Advisor met several deputations who appraised him about their grievances. The deputations demanded strengthening traffic police mechanism so that convenient movement of public is ensured. They also demanded establishment of truck terminal yard in the vicinity of fruit mundi besides establishing bus adda in the area. The people demanded a proper dumping site for proper management of solid waste. Moreover, various other issues of public importance viz power, water supply, ration supply etc were highlighted. The advisor assured them that their grievances will be redressed on priority.
