

DDC Chairs Public Grievance redressal Camp at Boniyar

Baramulla, July 19: District administration Baramulla today convened a public grievance redressal camp at Boniyaar Uri with District Development Commissioner Dr Nasir Ahmad Naqash in chair. The camp aimed to get the first hand appraisal of public grievances and to redress them in a time bound manner,

Chief Education Officer Baramulla, Chief Medical Officer Baramulla, Tehsildar Boniyar, Divisional forest officers, Assistant Director FCS&CA, Executive Engineers and various other district and Sectoral officers besides a huge gathering of public were present on the occasion.

On the occasion various civil society members and Senior citizens highlighted the main problems of the people wherein they sought proper, effective and timely action of the administration in solving their problems. They demanded renovation of telecommunication facility in the area adding that the area remains aloof due to poor network connectivity.
